1) What have you created that represents you well – either your whole identity, or a particular aspect of yourself?

2) What could people learn about you just by looking at what you have created?

3) Should we “tell and not tell” our children about difficult concepts? Should we tell them truths at an early age? What’s the best way to share knowledge?

4) How well do you understand how other peoples’ minds work? Do you enjoy trying to decipher the meaning behind others’ words, or do you prefer people to speak bluntly to you? Do you tend to be more straightforward when you speak, or do you find yourself relying on subtext and unspoken words more often than not?

5) How much of a normal interpersonal relationship is defined by unspoken understanding and subtext? Does it matter whether the relationship is platonic, familial, or romantic?
